RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING APRIL 2019 AS PUBLIC HEALTH MONTH IN FORSYTH COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA

WHEREAS since 1916, the Forsyth County Department of Public Health has provided vital public health services to a rapidly growing and changing population;

WHEREAS U.S. life expectancy has decreased in recent years and the three-year drop represents the longest sustained decline in expected lifespan since World War I; further, studies consistently show United States has a lower life expectancy than comparable countries;

WHEREAS public health professionals help communities prevent, prepare for, withstand and recover from the impact of a full range of health threats, including disease outbreaks such as measles and natural disasters;

WHEREAS public health action, together with scientific and technologic advances, has played a major role in reducing and in some cases eliminating the spread of infectious disease, and in establishing today's disease surveillance and control systems; and

WHEREAS 60% of Americans live with a preventable chronic disease, and health risks such as alcoholism, obesity and tobacco use are the primary reason for 7 of every 10 deaths annually in the United States;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners do hereby proclaim April 2019 as Public Health Month in Forsyth County and recognize April 6, 2019, as the 103rd anniversary of the Forsyth County Department of Public Health.
