Meeting Called to Order

A meeting of the Forsyth County Board of Elections was called to order in the 2nd Floor Board Room on Tuesday, October 15, 2024, at **5:00** p.m., Chairperson Robert Durrah, Jr. presiding.

Chairperson Robert L. Durrah, Jr. led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Absentee Ballots

Macy Payne, Absentee Ballots Manager, presented the Board with 2 military and 44 overseas absentee ballots for review and approval. Vice Chair Jourdan move to approve the military and overseas absentee ballots; Member Harvey seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Ballots that did not scan in the high-speed central counter due to tears, folds, or water damage were marked spoiled. The board members duplicated the ballots that were spoiled, and the ballots were properly scanned through the high-speed central counter.

Approval of Meeting Minutes

The individual was sent a thirty-day notice letter which they returned to the Board of Elections office, however, they did not state an objection to being removed as a registered voter due to their conviction. Member Draper moved to remove the said voter from the voter registration list; Secretary Doomy seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**
